

Welcome Parents to our very first Kids Garden Club!

We are really excited about planting seeds of health, wellness, and good food into the minds of the children.

Classes will be approx. one hour.

We will hold monthly classes the **3rd Saturday of each month**.
The classes will alternate between cooking lessons and gardening lessons.

Prior to the cooking sessions we will email out a list of fruits, veggies or supplies to bring that your child will need to prepare the days dish.
If the recipe calls for veggies we have growing, the children will be able to pick those fresh from the garden! :)

For the older children, you are welcome to drop them off and pick them back up at the end of our lesson.

Your \$10/mo. Membership Includes:

One Growing Space - If you have more than one child, they may share the space. If one space will not be enough you are welcome to purchase an additional space for \$10/mo.

Monthly Planting Guide - The children will get a list of all of the veggies they can choose from to plant each month. (one guide per family)

Seeds - We have a large variety of seeds to choose from but still may not have what your child wants to plant. Any local nursery will be able to supply any additional packets of seeds you need. They cost from \$2-\$3 a pack. You can also do a **seed swap** with other families as each packet has at least 20-30 seeds of which you will only need about 4 of them. *So... one parent can buy pumpkin seeds while another buys cucumber seeds and then you just share between the two.*

Water - Each space is automatically watered every day.

One Class each month - Taught by a Vegas Roots volunteer or a Star Nursery Employee (*if you have a skill or talent related to health, farming, garden craft, or the likes and would like to teach a session please let me know and we will add you to the calendar*)

Supplies to bring - (these are optional as we have a supply of used garden gloves and tools that the children can use. Walmart, Target or Home Depot have cute gardening sets for kids)

- gloves
- hand shovel
- watering can
- small scissors (to cut veggies when ready to harvest)
